Health Do's & Don'ts

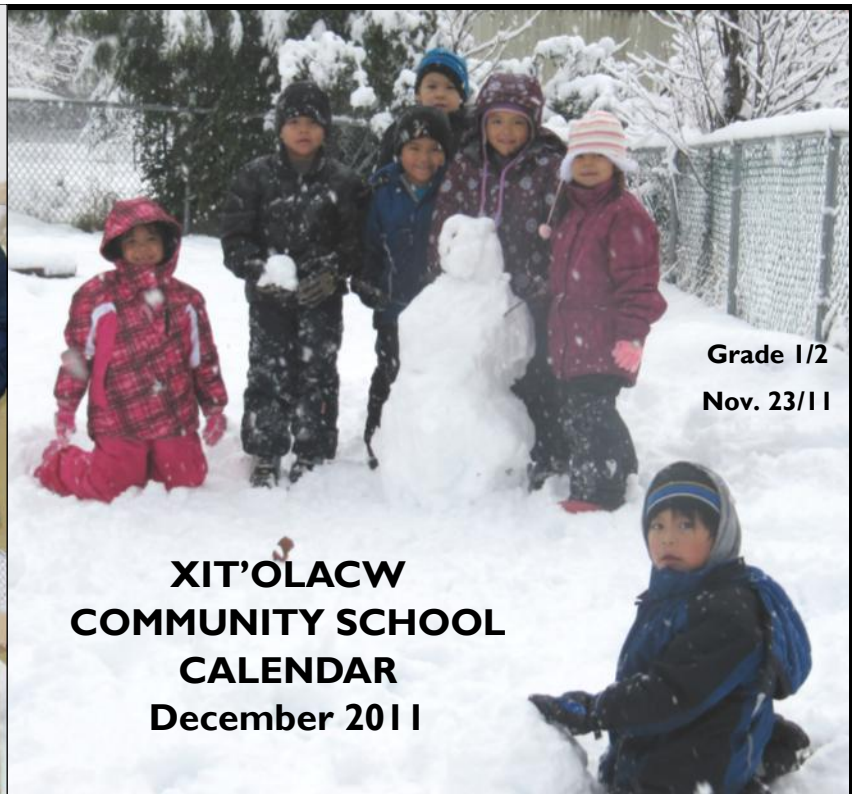
- Be Healthy
